Nomination papers for this election may be obtained from the Returning Officer at the offices of Cotswold District Council, Trinity Road, Cirencester, Glos, GL7 1PX, on any working day (excluding bank holidays) Monday to Friday between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm. The Returning Officer will, at the request of an elector, prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Completed nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Returning Officer at the offices of Cotswold District Council, Trinity Road, Cirencester, Glos, GL7 1PX on any working day (excluding bank holidays) Monday to Friday after the date of this notice between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm until Wednesday 25 April 2018 and between the hours of 9 am and 4 pm on Thursday 26 April 2018. **Completed nomination papers must be delivered by no later than 4 pm on Thursday 26 April 2018.**
3. If the election is contested, a poll will take place on Thursday 24 May 2018.
4. Applications to register to vote at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Trinity Road, Cirencester, Glos, GL7 1PX by midnight on Tuesday 8 May 2018.
5. Applications for, amendments to, or cancellations of postal votes, and amendments to or cancellations of proxy votes, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Trinity Road, Cirencester, Glos, GL7 1PX by 5 pm on Wednesday 9 May 2018.
6. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Trinity Road, Cirencester, Glos, GL7 1PX by 5 pm on Wednesday 16 May 2018.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Trinity Road, Cirencester, Glos, GL7 1PX by 5 pm on Thursday 24 May 2018. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday 16 May 2018; and to apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware after 5 pm on Wednesday 16 May 2018, that they cannot go to the polling station in person.
