**13/03097/OUT**, land parcel South of Home Farm, Cirencester Road, Fairford, Erection of up to 120 dwellings – **REFUSED**

**13/04567/TPO** Appledown House, The Croft, Fairford, Trees over the footpath between Fairford Hospital and Library - Prune off low branches interfering with footpath. Prune back selected long heavy branches above the wires as a crown thinning (not exceeding 25% of the number of branches overall) and leaving the same radial crown spread as existing - **PERMIT**

**13/04654/FUL**, Coln Park, Claydon Pike, Substitution of approved unit type from the Yoo 4 solarium to the standard Yoo 4 with re-orientate and additional land creation (05.12.13) – **no comment**

Discussion took place, in particular with reference to the SofState recent ruling in Tetbury in which a definitive figure of 2442 houses to satisfy the 5 year housing supply in the Cotswold District was mentioned. Mr Megson advised FTC that, despite Glos H'ways having no objection to the access in the application, FTC can continue to object on those grounds as we firmly believe that it is unsafe.
